Youth Day School Holiday (7 July)

6. As Youth Day, Monday, 7 July 2025, is a scheduled school holiday, students will return to school on Tuesday, 8 July 2025.

English Week (8-11 July)

7. From 8 to 11 July, our students will take part in *Fun Using English (FUSE)*—a week dedicated to celebrating the English language in creative and engaging ways. The aim of EL Week is to cultivate a love for English by offering meaningful opportunities for students to read, write, speak, and be creative with the language. One of the highlights includes Book Character Day on 8 July, a platform for our students to portray their love for reading. On this day, they will dress up and share about some of their favourite characters from books with their friends. Students can also look forward to a Book Buzz session by NLB as well as games and level–specific English activities, all designed to make language learning fun, purposeful and inspiring.

National Education (NE) Show 2025 for P5 Students (19 July)

8. Our P5 students will be provided with the opportunity to attend the NE show as part of our National Education programme on Saturday, 19 July 2025. The organisation of the NE show dates back to 1997 in order to instill a sense of pride and belonging in our students and to bring across the significance of our National Day. Every year, the National Day Parade (NDP) full dress rehearsal provides an opportunity to inculcate NE values in our students. All P5 students are strongly encouraged to attend the NE Show. Racial Harmony Day (21 July)

9. QtPS will be commemorating Racial Harmony Day (RHD) on Monday, 21 July 2025. The theme for RHD is 'Our People, Our Tapestry.' Queenstowners will learn to understand the importance of values like respect and empathy in their daily interactions with others on this day through the various activities conducted.

e-Learning Day and P6 Preliminary Oral Examinations (28 – 29 July)

- 10. Our P6 students will be having their P6 Preliminary English and Mother Tongue Oral Examinations on the Monday, 28 July 2025 and Tuesday, 29 July 2025. P6 students will be given separate instructions and more details on this in due course.
- 11. In order to provide a conducive examination environment for our P6 students, P1-P5 students will not be required to come to school on Monday, 28 July 2025 and Tuesday, 29 July 2025. They will be assigned e-learning tasks instead. More information will be provided by the respective subject teachers closer to the examination dates.

General Information

Mobile Phones and Smart Devices

- 12. In my earlier Open Letters since January, I had shared about our school's guidelines on the usage of mobile phones and smart devices. This is a reminder that students are not to use their smartphones and/or smartwatches (other than the POSB Smart Buddy Watch) during school hours (including recess, CCA and after-school programmes).
- 13. Students are strongly encouraged not to bring such devices to school. Nonetheless, should they bring such devices, they are to place them in their school bags before the start of the school day. This applies even to smartwatches that parents have set to the "class/school mode". MOE guidelines require students to be free from smartphones and smart devices during school hours.
- 14. Students should bear the responsibility for the safekeeping of their mobile phones or smart devices. The school will not bear responsibility for the loss of, damage to or theft of students' mobile phones or smart devices.

Student Absence feature on Parents Gateway

- 15. The new Student Absence feature on Parents Gateway (PG) will be made available to Queenstown Primary School from Term 3 2025. With this feature, parents/guardians will be able to submit reasons for their child/ward's absence and upload supporting documents such as medical certificates directly through the app.
