Concluding Remarks

16. Term 3 will be an eventful term with many student development experiences. Students may also start to feel the rigour and demands of the curriculum this term. To support our students as they continue to learn and grow, we would like to encourage them to embody the value of **resilience** in leading and managing themselves deliberately and mindfully this term. We hope to instill in our students the ability to bounce back quickly from setbacks and struggles while holding on to their core values and beliefs.

Please find below some strategies that you can use to develop resilience in your child:

Be <u>Empathetic</u>	This refers to the capacity of parents to put themselves in the shoes of their children and to see the world through their eyes. What matters most to our children is for their parents to understand what they are going through instead of being upset with or disappointed in them.
Set realistic goals	Guide children in setting attainable goals that align with their abilities and interests. This allows them to experience a sense of accomplishment and help them build confidence along the way.
Help children recognise that <u>mistakes are</u> <u>experiences from which to learn from</u>	Resilient children tend to view mistakes as opportunities for growth and learning while those who are not as hopeful often see mistakes as failures. Emphasise that mistakes are not only accepted, but also expected. Let children know that they are accepted and loved even when they make mistakes. This will inadvertently serve as models for dealing with mistakes and setbacks in the future.
Teach children to <u>solve problems</u> and <u>make</u> <u>decisions</u>	Teach children to solve problems and make decisions. Resilient children define problems, consider different solutions, attempt what they judge to be the most appropriate solutions and learn from the outcome. To reinforce this problem-solving attitude, parents are strongly encouraged to engage their children in thinking about possible solutions instead of offering

action plans with the guidance of parents, their	
sense of ownership and control is reinforced.	

Allow me to share with you a short story of resilience. Do challenge yourself to guess who this resilient person might be before you reach the end of the story!

17. Once upon a time, in the quaint town of Edinburgh, there lived a determined woman. Despite facing financial difficulties and the loss of her mother, she pressed on, writing away in coffee shops, breathing life into the words that she wrote. She created a magical world through her descriptive and interesting style of writing.

However, when she sent her manuscript to publishers, countless rejection letters piled up. Being resilient, she refused to let them deter her. Finally, her perseverance paid off when a small publishing house, Bloomsbury, recognised the magic within her pages and decided to take a chance on her novel. Her books flew off the shelves once published and the woman became a household name. The world was changed forever. The book captivated readers of all ages, igniting a literary phenomenon like no other.

Despite the overwhelming success that followed, she faced additional obstacles along her journey. Criticism, controversies, and personal struggles threatened to overshadow her accomplishments. Yet, her resilience shone through as she remained unyielding and she continues to create magical worlds that bring joy to millions even today.

This incredible woman's story is a testament to the power of resilience. She teaches us that no matter the challenges we face, with determination and unwavering belief in ourselves, we can overcome any obstacle and create magic in our own lives. Her name? J.K. Rowling.
