### In Celebration

#### The Queen's Commonwealth Essay Competition 2025

3. Our Queenstowners took part in the Queen's Commonwealth Essay Competition (QCEC) last year. The QCEC is the world's oldest international writing competition for schools. Each year, young people write on a theme that stems from the Commonwealth's values and principles. The theme for 2025 was "Our Commonwealth Journey" which asked entrants to consider the relevance of journeys in a Commonwealth context, whether geographical, historical or personal. Some of our Queenstowners have achieved awards in the competition. Well done! Please refer to Annex A for our list of award winners.

### Upcoming Events

#### Briefing for P5 & P6 Parents/Guardians (5 Feb)

4. Over the last 2 weeks, we met the Parents/Guardians of our P1-P4 students. As mentioned in my January Open Letter, the annual Briefing for P5 & P6 Parents will be held face to face in our QtPS campus on 5 February, 3-4.30pm. The objective of this briefing is to keep you informed and updated on school matters related to your child's/ward's education. More information about the briefing sessions will be made available to you via PG.

#### Total Defence Day (9 Feb)

5. The school will commemorate Total Defence Day on Monday, 9 February 2026. This year marks 42 years of Total Defence in Singapore, which was introduced in 1984.

6. As part of the commemoration, Queenstown Primary School will involve all students in Exercise SG Ready through a power disruption simulation conducted in classrooms during assembly periods. The simulation aims to help students understand and prepare for possible disruptions that may affect various aspects of our daily lives, such as access to electricity, water,

food supplies, and digital connectivity. Such disruptions may arise due to factors including climate change, geopolitical tensions, protectionism, and increasing digital vulnerabilities.

7. During the exercise, all classroom lights and fans will be switched off for a total period of 45 minutes during the assembly lessons in classes on 9 and 11 February, though the school will assess the situation dynamically based on adjacent construction works and may adjust this arrangement as needed. Through this experience, students will gain first-hand insight into the impact of power disruption. Guided discussions and reflections will then be facilitated by teachers during the FTGP lessons to help students process their learning.

8. Parents and guardians are encouraged to engage your child/ward in conversations about his/her experience and to reinforce the important message that everyone has a role to play in Singapore's Total Defence efforts. You may also wish to remind your child of the QtPS GRACE values — Gratitude, Resilience, Accountability, Care and Empathy — as these values will help prepare them for the exercise.

9. We seek your support in working together to provide our students with an authentic and meaningful learning experience through the power disruption simulation this 2026 Total Defence Day Commemoration.

#### **Chinese New Year (CNY) Celebrations (16 Feb from 7.30 am to 10.30 am ) and Public Holidays (17-18 Feb)**

10. QtPS will be celebrating the Chinese New Year on Monday, 16 February. Students are to report to school by 7.30am as usual. This year, we celebrate the Year of the Horse! Students are encouraged to come dressed in their traditional attire/red tops and their school shorts/skorts, school socks, and school shoes. As part of the celebration, students will be dismissed at 10.30 am on 16 February. Please note that there will be no recess, but students may bring their own snacks for snack break.

11. Bus services will be provided for students taking the school bus on that day.

12. Please note that as Tuesday, 17 February and Wednesday, 18 February are public holidays, school will thus resume on Thursday, 19 February. We wish all celebrating Queenstowners and their families a Happy Chinese New Year! To the rest of our Queenstown Family, Happy Holidays!

#### **Safer Internet Day**

13. Safer Internet Day 2026 will be observed under the national theme "*Practise Healthy Digital Habits Together*," which encourages students to set boundaries for screen use, think before acting online, report inappropriate content, and seek help from trusted adults. At Queenstown Primary School, we will observe Safer Internet Day in the last week of February, with Cyber Wellness lessons and assembly sharing. Google's Online Safety Park will also be set up for students to visit during recess, complementing our in-school lessons. Parents will receive a Parents Gateway message from MOE on 10 February 2026, and we encourage families to continue these conversations at home as we work in partnership to support our children's digital well-being.
